HIPAA issues addressed by SofTrack

- **Procedures for automatic logoff (§ 164.308(a)(4))**

SofTrack includes the ability to detect idle applications and automatically terminate use. Because many medical applications require the user to sign-on, this ability ensures that any application interface used to access sensitive medical records, also known as Protected Health Information (PHI), will be automatically terminated upon a predefined idle timeout period.

- **Procedures for guarding against malicious software (§ 164.308(a)(5))**

SofTrack includes the unique ability to deny creation and renaming of executable files. This feature supplements your current anti-virus protection by ensuring unauthorized executable files are not created.

Additionally, SofTrack can be configured to block the use of any executable file that possesses an incorrect file extension. Normally only files ending with a .EXE or .COM extension can be launched, however, Windows allows files with any extension to be launched. SofTrack protects against such files to help further protect your network against malicious software.

Further protection is provided by SofTrack's ability to block the use of any specifically named executable file such as FTP.EXE, SETUP.EXE and so on.

- **Procedures for recording system activity (§ 164.312(b))**

SofTrack includes the ability to record all of the following events per workstation:

- File Open
- File Copy
- File Create
- Application Launch
- Any Browser page requests

With SofTrack you will have an audit trail of these events occurring at each workstation. Every record includes the workstation name, workstation TCP/IP address, name of the user requesting the activity and the time occurred.

- **Procedures for documentation of workstation hardware and software inventory (§ 164.316(b)(1))**

SofTrack includes the ability to quickly document hardware and software configurations of your workstations. Data collected per workstation includes:

- Workstation Name
- TCP/IP address
- Workstation Manufacturer
- Workstation Model
- Workstation Serial Number
- Memory Configuration
- Video Adapter details
- Network Adapters installed
- Operating System / Version
- Hotfixes and Patches installed
- Applications installed including Publisher and Serial Number
